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Role of TPA in Draft Work Program

Section 339.135, F.S.

(4)c.2: The district work program shall be developed cooperatively with the TPA and include, to the maximum extent feasible, the project priorities of the TPA

(4)d: FDOT shall make a presentation to the TPA to determine

- the necessity of making any changes to projects included or to be included in the district work program and
- to hear requests for new projects to be added to, or existing projects to be deleted from, the district work program

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
State Road Modifications (SRM)


Five Year Target: ~\$101M Federal & State Funds

Programmed for TPA Priorities: ~\$63M Federal & State Funds + \$77M Local Initiatives for SRM Projects, including SR-80 Lighting, Atlantic Ave widening, and SR-7 Extension

Updates to existing projects

Yr/Rank	Project
04-1	SR 7: 60^{th} St to Northlake Blvd – Delayed to >FY 28 and increase from \$59 M to \$87.5 M
04-2	SR-7: Okeechobee Blvd to 60^{th} St – Delayed to FY 28 and increase from \$21 M to \$39.6 M
14-3	Atlantic Ave: SR-7 to Lyons Rd – on schedule for FY 24
16-1	Atlantic Ave: Lyons Rd to Turnpike – on schedule for FY 27 Atlantic Ave: Turnpike to Jog Rd – construction still outside work program




