



Summary of the DTWP in Palm Beach County



: TPA's Direct Formula Funding

~\$30 M / Year to Prioritize

Surface Transportation Block Grant (SU) Program

~\$23 M/year - TPA policy: Local Initiatives Program

Transportation Alternatives (TALU & TALT) set-aside

~\$5 M/year – TPA policy: Transportation Alternatives Program

Carbon Reduction Program (CARU)

~\$2.8 M/year – TPA staff direction: fund SU & TA eligible projects



Transportation Improvement Program


Projects programmed for FDOT funding over the next 5 years

- **31** State Road Modifications Projects = ~\$119M
- 23 Local Initiatives Projects=~\$124M
- **13** Transportation Alternatives Projects = ~\$16.7M

→ New Priority Projects added to new TIP outer year, pending FDOT funding availability.



Summary of Draft Tentative Work Program Updates for FY 24 -28

State Road Modifications (SRM)

Five Year Target: ~\$101M Federal & State Funds

Programmed for TPA Priorities: ~\$63M Federal & State Funds + \$77M Local Initiatives for SRM Projects, including SR-80 Lighting, Atlantic Ave widening, and SR-7 Extension




