When is a TIP Amendment Needed?

- Add or delete a project
- Cost increases more than 20% and \$2 million
- Changes to scope of work
 - Length change by ½ mile and 20%
 - Number of through traffic lanes
- Change to project phase initiation date


Only impacts projects in the Amendment

Lindell Blvd and SW 10th Ave (4415331) Add funds and changes length

Proposed Changes

- **Location:** Lindell Blvd and SW 10th Ave from West of S Dixie Hwy to Linton Blvd
- **Length:** .58 mi to 1.3 mi
 - Clerical error: does not increase cost
- **Funding:** Increase federal funding reimbursement by \$2,422,292

Add Two New Projects

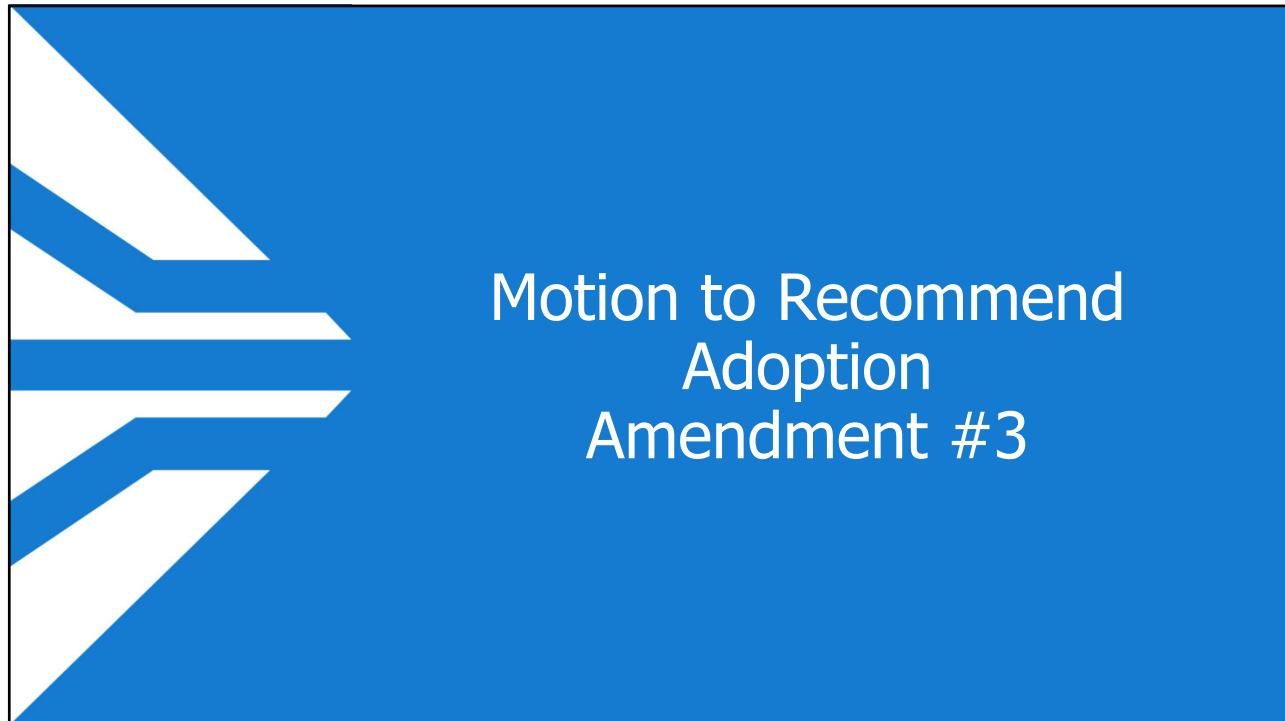
Statewide Rumble Strips (4522261)

- **Location:** District 4 Palm Beach & Broward
- **Funding in FY 2023:** Adds \$75,000 in design

Palm Tran 5310 Operating Assistance (4524581)

- Transportation services to meet the special transportation needs of seniors and individuals with disabilities.
- **Funding in FY 2023:**
 - \$50,000 FTA Section 5310
 - \$50,000 local funds
