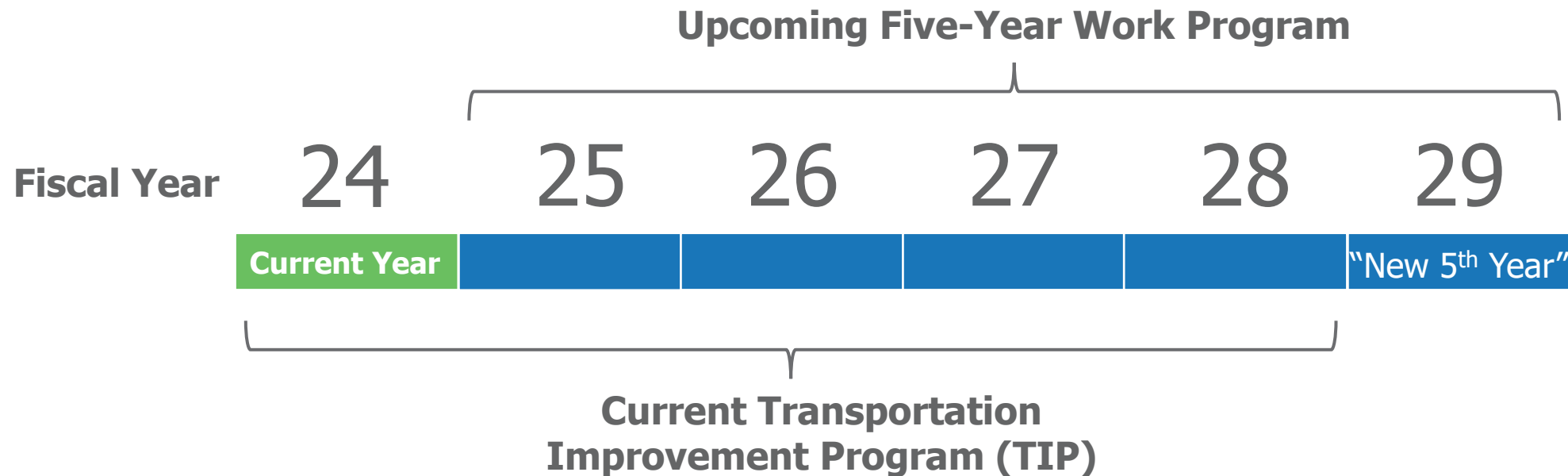

Draft list of projects by phase and funding for the 5 years

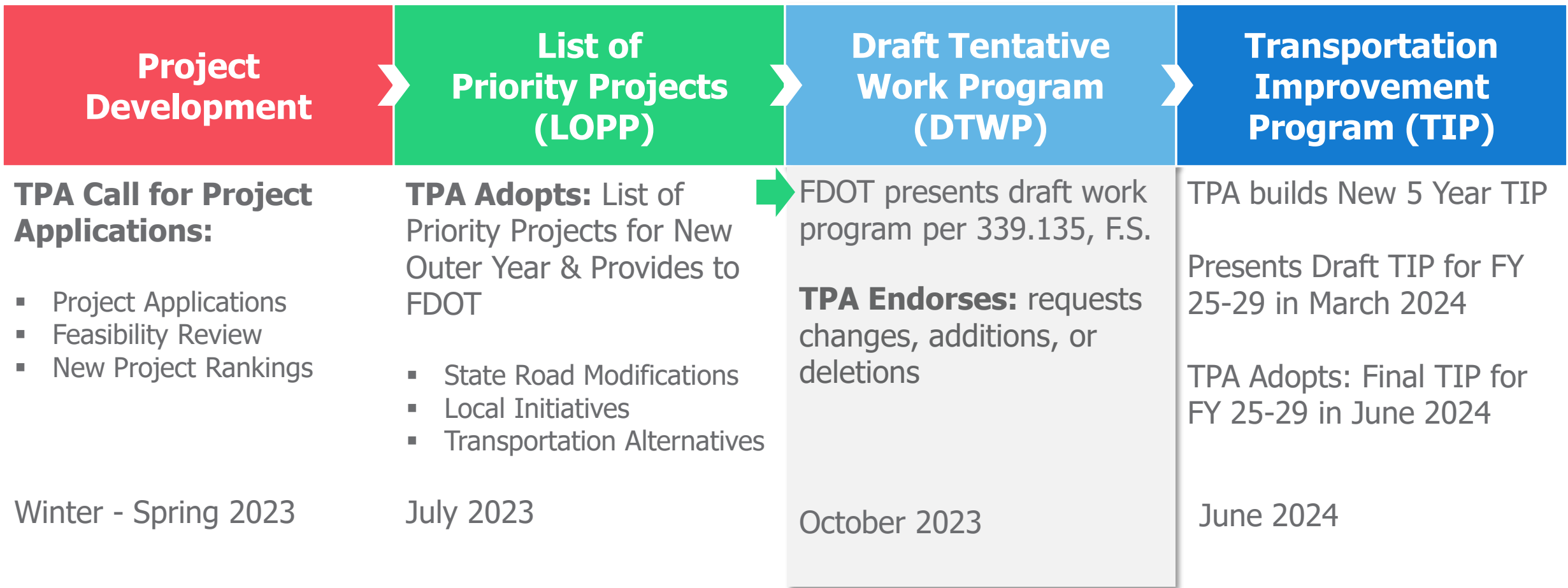

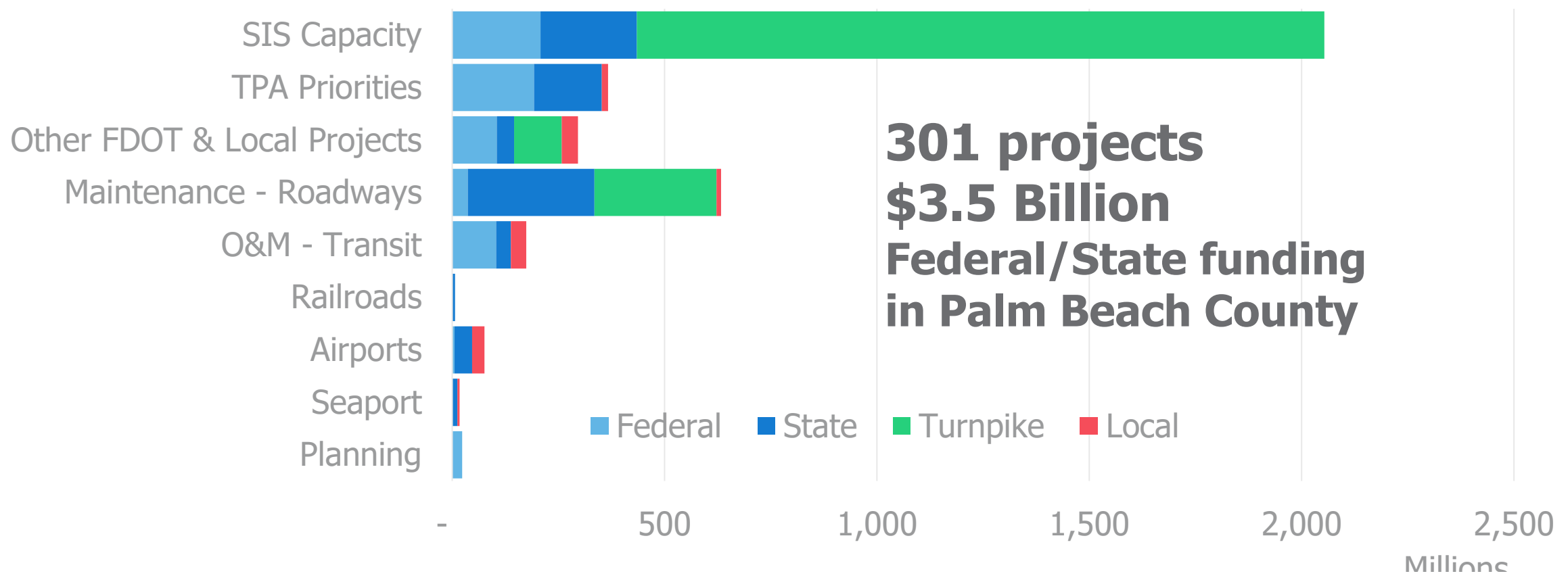

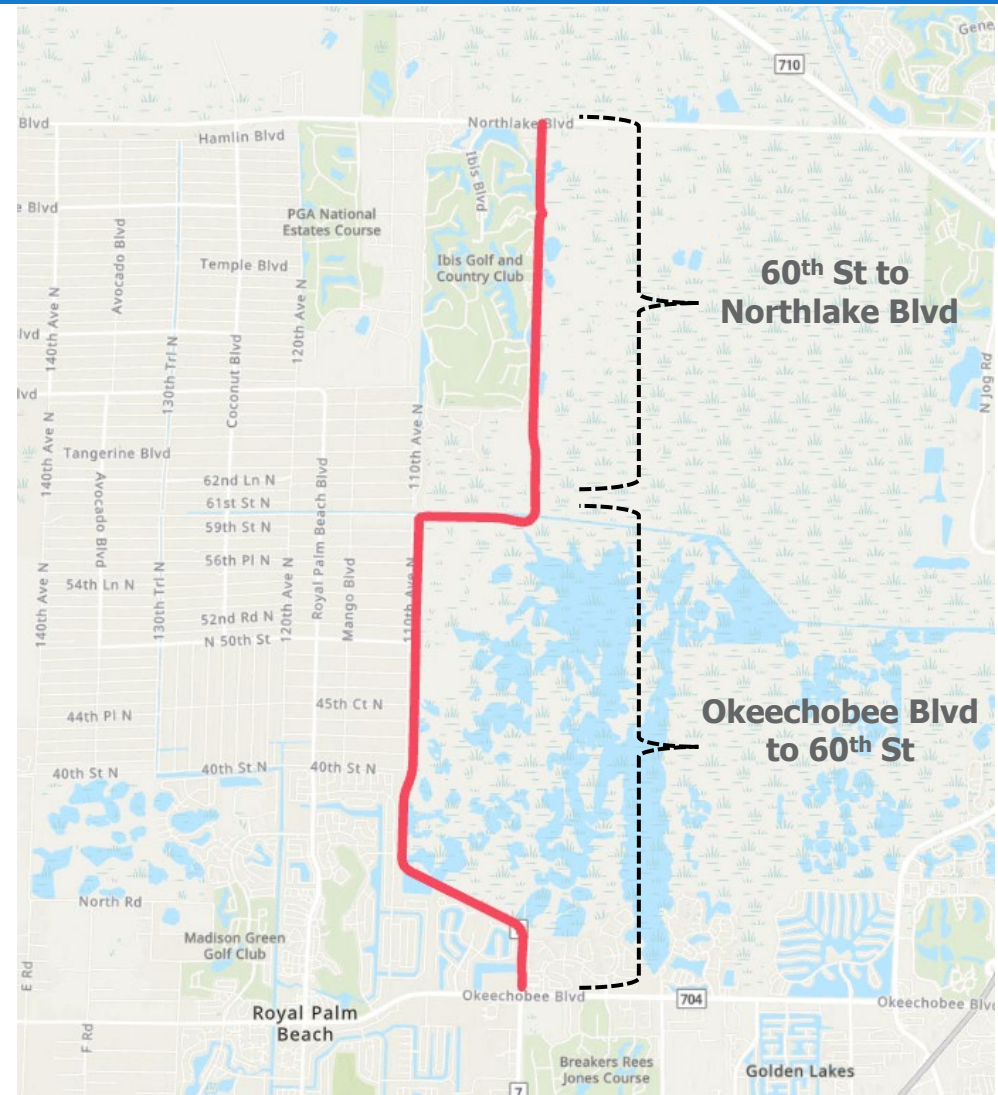
Hearing on the environmental resource permit began October 16

Construction in FY 2028 for \$35 M





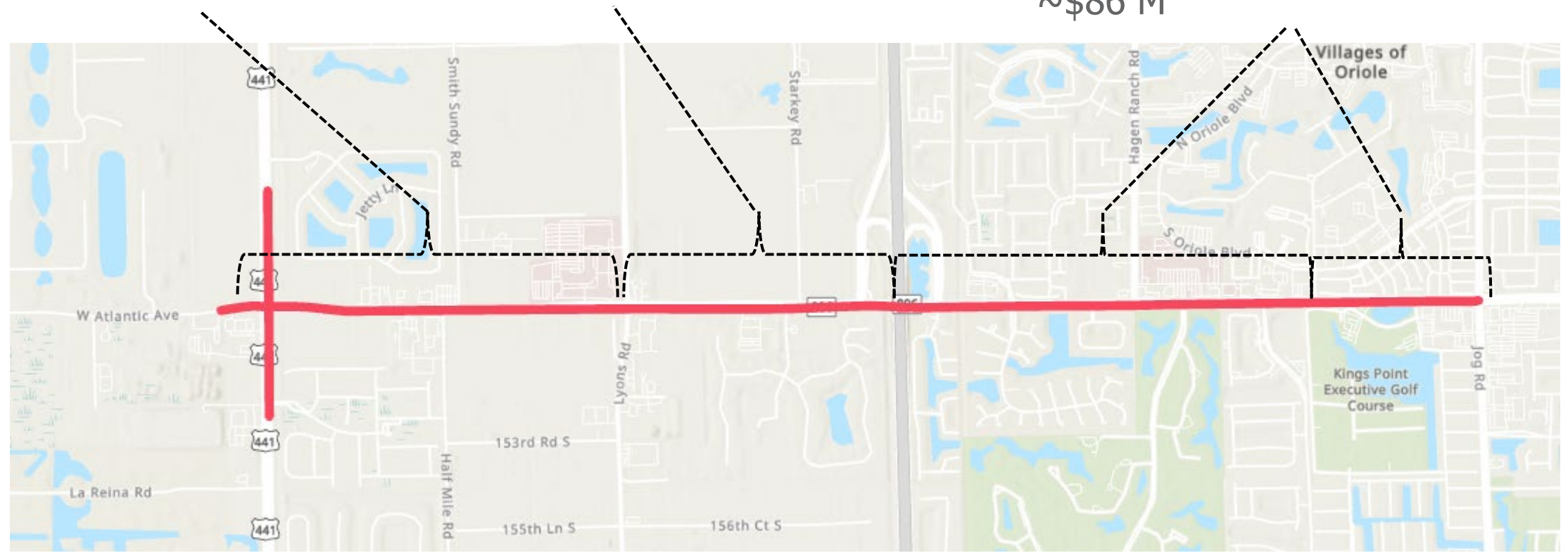

~\$86 M





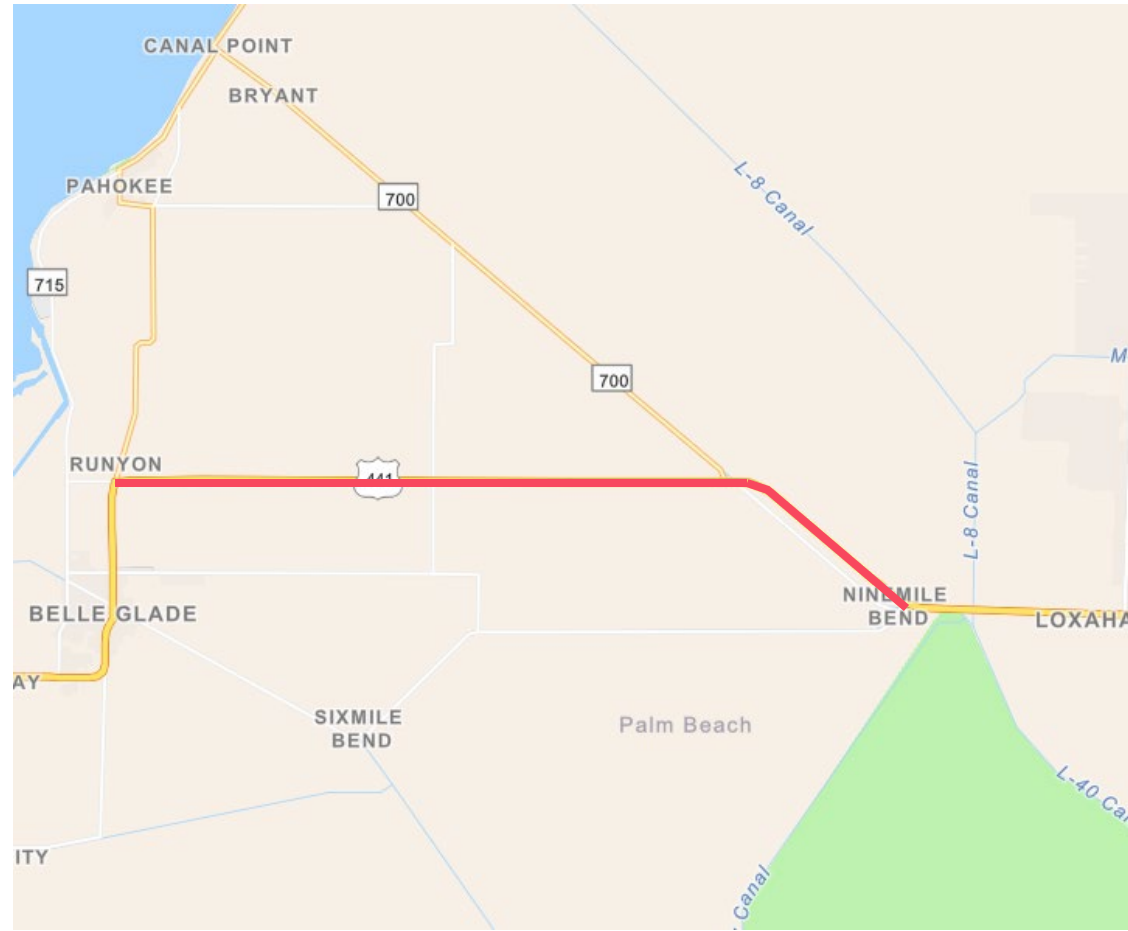



# State Road 80 Lighting

**Total cost:** ~\$24 Million

**Currently:** FPL is working on getting permits with the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) and US Army Corps of Engineers.

**Construction Schedule:** Florida Power & Light (FPL) indicated a January 31, 2024 start date and a March 26, 2025 completion date.
