- Updated Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Plan with the U.S. Census Bureau's data

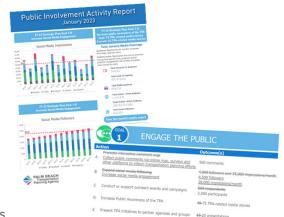
