2. ACTION ITEMS

A. MOTION TO ELECT VZAC Vice Chair

B. <u>MOTION TO RECOMMEND APPROVAL</u> of the TPA's Public Participation Plan (PPP) Update

The TPA's PPP establishes policies and procedures for public engagement, including notice of proposed actions and opportunity for input. The draft document is attached and also available at PalmBeachTPA.org/Public-Participation-Plan. Updates include:




