2. ACTION ITEMS

A. MOTION TO ELECT VZAC Vice Chair

Pursuant to the TPA Operating Procedures, Section 5.3.B, states "additional elections may be held as necessary if an officer cannot carry out their duties and complete the remainder of the appointed term." John Roach resigned from the City of West Palm Beach and is unable to complete the remainder of his term, therefore, a new Vice Chair will need to be elected to serve for the remainder of the calendar year.

B. MOTION TO RECOMMEND APPROVAL of the TPA's Public Participation Plan (PPP) Update

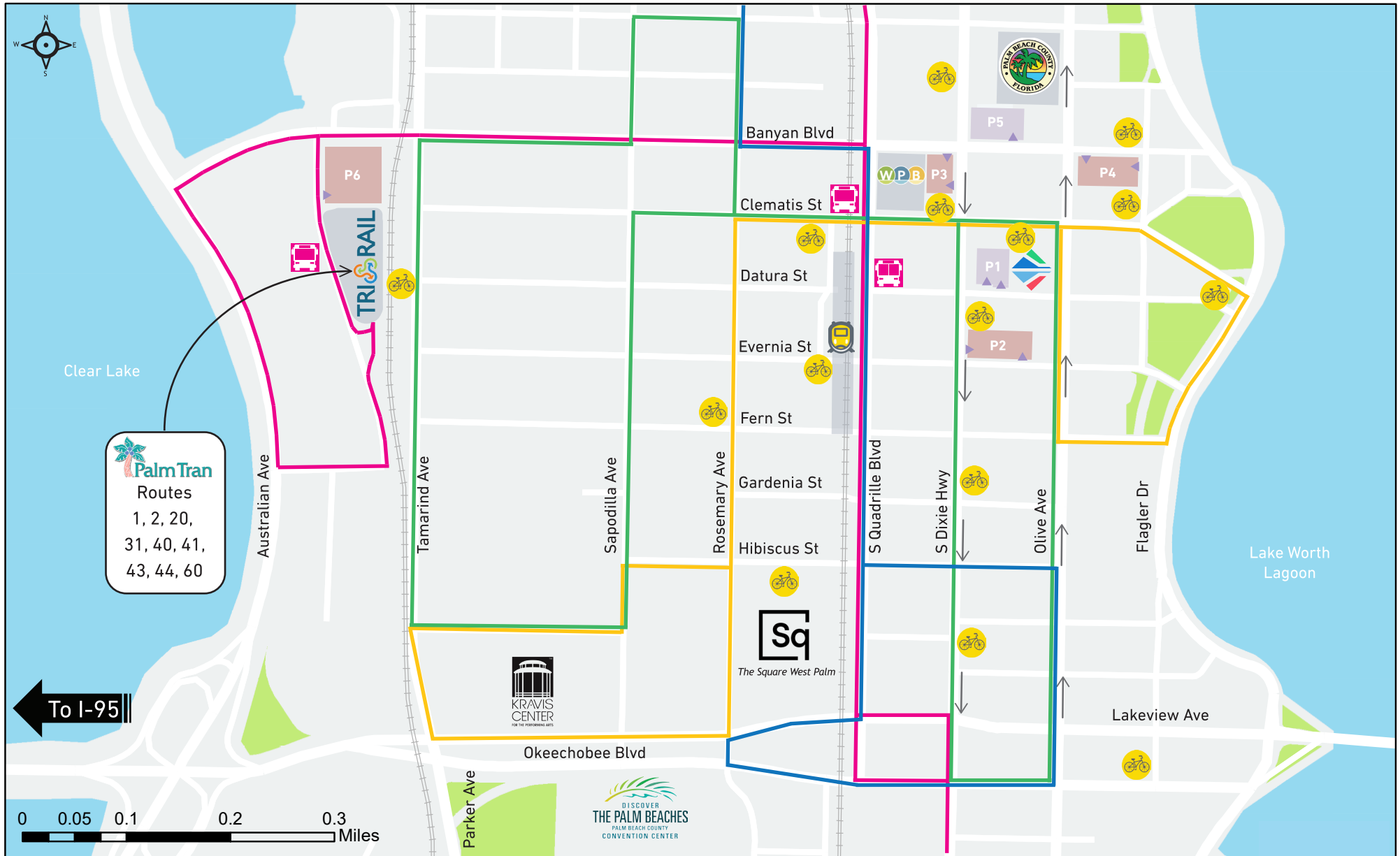
