2. ACTION ITEMS

A. <u>MOTION TO RECOMMEND ADOPTION</u> of Amendment #1 to the TPA's Fiscal Year (FY) 24-28 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

The TIP is the five-year funding program for transportation projects in Palm Beach County. This FY 24-28 TIP amendment includes the following:

- Rolling of project phases not encumbered in FY 23 into FY 24
- Increases in costs of SR-700/Connors Hwy resurfacing (4463741)
- Addition of a design oversight phase to a new SW 18th Transportation Alternatives project (4507841)

B. <u>MOTION TO RECOMMEND ADOPTION</u> of Amendment #1 to the Fiscal Year (FY) 25-29 List of Priority Projects (LOPP)

The LOPP guides the development of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT)'s Five-Year Work Program and the TPA's TIP. The FY 25-29 LOPP is organized into Major Projects on State roadways, Local Initiatives projects, and Transportation Alternative projects. This LOPP amendment is includes:

- Re-inclusion of Major Project 17-1f US 1 Lane Repurposing in North Palm Beach (4383867)
- Funding requests for Shared-Use Nonmotorized (SUN) Trail projects
- Notes for State roadway projects eligible to receive SUN Trail funding

3. INFORMATION ITEMS

A. First Review of Amendment #2 to the TPA's 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) Cost Feasible Plan

The 2045 LRTP Cost Feasible Plan programs federal and state funding for transportation projects in Palm Beach County over the next 25 years. This amendment updates federal and state revenues and cost estimates for FDOT and TPA priorities. The majority of the changes are administrative modifications to ensure consistency with the FDOT Work Program and TPA TIP. The amendments are projects with cost increases of more than 50% and \$50 million, significant expansion of scope or phasing, or advancement of construction. The 2045 LRTP changes are attached. The final version of the amendment will be presented for approval in October.

B. TPA Vision 2050 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) Update – Call for Projects

TPA staff will provide an update on the 2050 LRTP and discuss how to submit local projects for evaluation and prioritization.

C. FDOT Shared-Use Nonmotorized (SUN) Trail Program

The SUN Trails Program was created to develop a statewide system of paved multiuse trails for bicyclists and pedestrians. In 2023's Florida Legislative Session, the annual recurring \$25M allocation was increased to \$50M along with a one-time allocation of \$200M for the program. A presentation on the program, project eligibility, funding availability, and timeline are attached.
