#### 2. ACTION ITEMS

A. <u>MOTION TO RECOMMEND ADOPTION</u> of Amendment #2 to the TPA's 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) Cost Feasible Plan

The 2045 LRTP Cost Feasible Plan programs federal and state funding for transportation projects in Palm Beach County over the next 25 years. This amendment updates federal and state revenues and cost estimates for FDOT and TPA priorities. The majority of the changes are administrative modifications to ensure consistency with the FDOT Work Program and TPA TIP. The amendments are projects with cost increases of more than 50% and \$50 million, significant expansion of scope or phasing, or advancement of construction. The 2045 LRTP changes are attached.

### 3. INFORMATION ITEMS

A. TPA Apportionment Plan, Urban Area Boundary, and Functional Classification Update

Every ten years, after the U.S. Decennial Census, FDOT and the TPA have the opportunity to adjust and revise the TPA Apportionment Plan, Urban Boundary, and Functional Classification of the roadway network. TPA staff will present a summary of this process attached.
