

# TPA INVESTMENT PRIORITIES

The TPA Priority Projects are consistent with the goals, objectives and values of the TPA's adopted Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and further the TPA vision of creating a safe, efficient, and connected multimodal transportation system.

## MAJOR TPA PROJECTS

Major highway, transit and freight projects prioritized from the LRTP with federal and state funds, plus \$1,638,017 in local funds.

## IN LOCAL INITIATIVES PROGRAM

Lower cost, non-regionally significant projects with federal and state funds submitted annually to the TPA by local agencies. Projects are prioritized using a project scoring system based on adopted goals, objectives and values in the LRTP, plus \$36,388,881 in local funds.
