LRTP Purpose




- TPA transportation vision to 2050
- Living document, major update every 5 years
- Meet federal/state requirements for urbanized area transportation planning process
- Guides federal and state transportation funding
- Pipeline for the TIP development

- ✓ Moved "Other Local Projects Submitted during the Call for Projects" into the Appendices
- ✓ Included Scenario Planning Summary Transit Desires, Autonomous/Connected Vehicles Technology, and Telecommuting





Local desires that are either not eligible for State / Federal funding or need to demonstrate planning consistency and or align with TPA / Federal goals






- ✓ Mobility on Demand Zones
 - Palm Tran and local MOD services
- **✓ Express Buses**
 - Capital funds to support new buses and park and ride
- ✓ Intelligent Transportation w/ Transit Signal Priority
 - National Highway System (NHS) and 561 network





- **✓ Refined Active Transportation Network**
 - Prioritize low stress networks on the Federal Aid Eligible Network
 - Complete streets to support walking, bicycling, and micromobility
- ✓ Freight Activity Areas
- **✓ Electric and Alternative Fuel Corridors**
- **✓ Feasibility Studies**
 - Complete Streets, SUN Trail
 - Freight logistics, grade separations, and infrastructure resilience


