### 2. ACTION ITEMS

- A. MOTION TO RECOMMEND ADOPTION of Amendment #4 to the TPA's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)  
The TIP is the TPA's five-year funding program for transportation projects in Palm Beach County. TPA staff will present on the following attached FDOT amendment requests for the FY 2024-2028 TIP:
  - SR-807/Congress Avenue at 10<sup>th</sup> North (4493471) – add a new right-of-way phase of \$590,793.
