Α. MOTION TO RECOMMEND APPROVAL of the 2025 Transportation Alternatives (TA) **Program Guidelines**

TPA staff will present the attached TA Program Guidelines. The TA Program is a costreimbursement program for nonmotorized, and safety projects prioritized by the TPA Governing Board on an annual competitive basis. \$5.1 million is estimated to be available for prioritization in FY 2024 with funding in FY 2027.
