**2.B. MOTION TO RECOMMEND ADOPTION of the Vision 2050 Long Range Transportation PLAN (LRTP)**

Jim Bell joined the meeting at 9:43am.

Jessica Keller joined the meeting at 9:49am.

STEWART ROBERTSON, Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. representative, provided a presentation.

MOTASEM AL-TURK asked which corridors are included in the traffic signal maps displayed in the presentation.

ALEX HANSEN suggested cross-referencing the data on the maps presented pertaining to separate bike line facilities and mileages to ensure it accurately reflects the current facilities in place. He also expressed concerns on changing the location and description of Major Project 14-1 that expands the passenger rail service scope to all Palm Beach County instead of being focused on the West Palm Beach to Jupiter extension.

BRIAN RUSCHER, Deputy Director of Multimodal, confirmed the change in scope does not negatively impact implementation of the northern extension.

KHURSHID MOHYUDDIN asked if there is a map available that shows capacity improvement for county and major roadways.

BRYAN DAVIS asked for clarification as to why there was no reference of a county comprehensive plan for Greenacres, Belle Glade and Jupiter in the LRTP.

NATALIE CROWLEY thanked TPA staff and consultants for their work on the LRTP.

ALEX HANSEN noted that he would vote against the item due to the inclusion of State Road 7.

ANDREW UHLIR, Deputy Director of Programs, Jessica Rubio, Florida Department of Transportation Liaison and James Brown Jr, Florida Turnpike Enterprise Liaison provided a presentation.

There were no public comments on this item.

ALEX HANSEN noted that he would vote against the item due to the inclusion of State Road 7.

BRYAN DAVIS inquired about whether the expansion of the right of way project between the Turnpike and Jog Road could be a follow up item.

JIM BELL asked if the FDOT truck parking at the Peninsula Corporate Center in Boca will include Fleet Parking. CESAR MARTINEZ, FDOT, noted that the parking facility will be open to the public for use, including ten spaces with overnight parking.

MOTASEM AL-TURK asked for a follow up on the progress of adding access points to the Turnpike on Hypoluxo Road.

ALEX HANSEN asked if projects such as beeline to PGA could be combined to the north or the south to reduce congestion.

CHANG-JEN LAN noted that there was no direct connection of I-95 to the Turnpike in the study. James Brown Jr stated the PD&E study is currently being conducted and is an unfunded project for this cycle.
