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

# LRTP Purpose




- ◆ TPA transportation vision to 2050
- Living document, major update every 5 years
- Meet federal/state requirements for urbanized area transportation planning process
- Guides federal and state transportation funding
- Pipeline for the TIP development





# LRTP Project Sections

#### **Cost Feasible**

Identified to be funded with fed/state funding (ex. TPA or Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) funding)

**Includes Feasibility Studies** 

#### **Illustrative**

Unfunded TPA desires

May require other sources of funding (ex. O&M, discretionary grants)

May require additional evaluation

#### **Other Local Desires**

Additional local desires that are either not eligible for State / Federal funding or need to demonstrate planning consistency and or align with TPA / Federal goals
