









Identifying New Priorities: Call for Projects


- Closed on December 16, 2023

 - Over 550 projects








Vision 2050 Local Projects Database

- Interactive Map for Public and Stakeholder Review










TPA Prioritization Supports Additional Funding Opportunities




Including a project in the LRTP Illustrative List or Cost Feasible Plan indicates the TPA's "Support" for the use of Federal & State funding.
