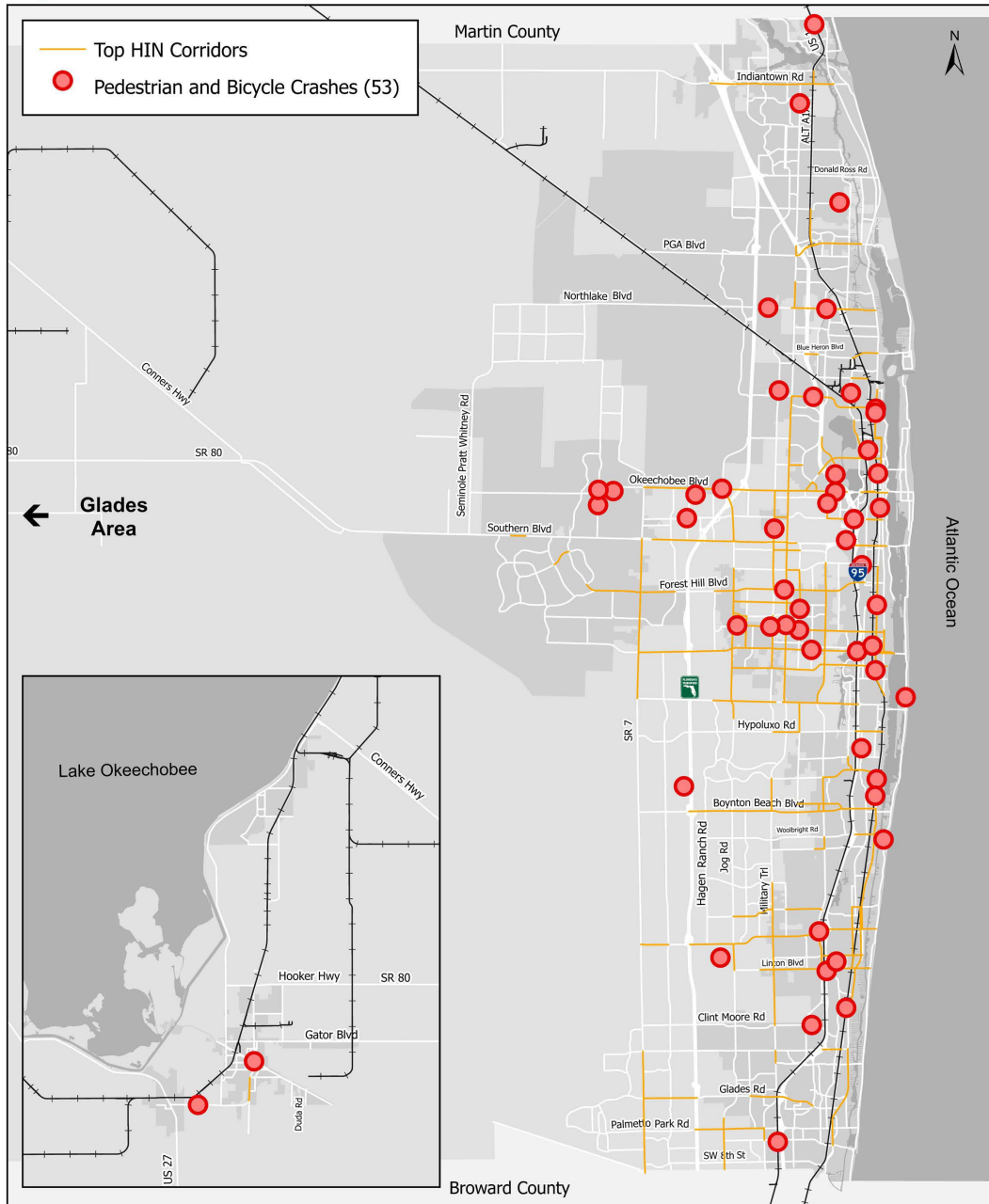

- Accumulated data reveals trends and countermeasures



### Crashes on the High Injury Network within Palm Beach County



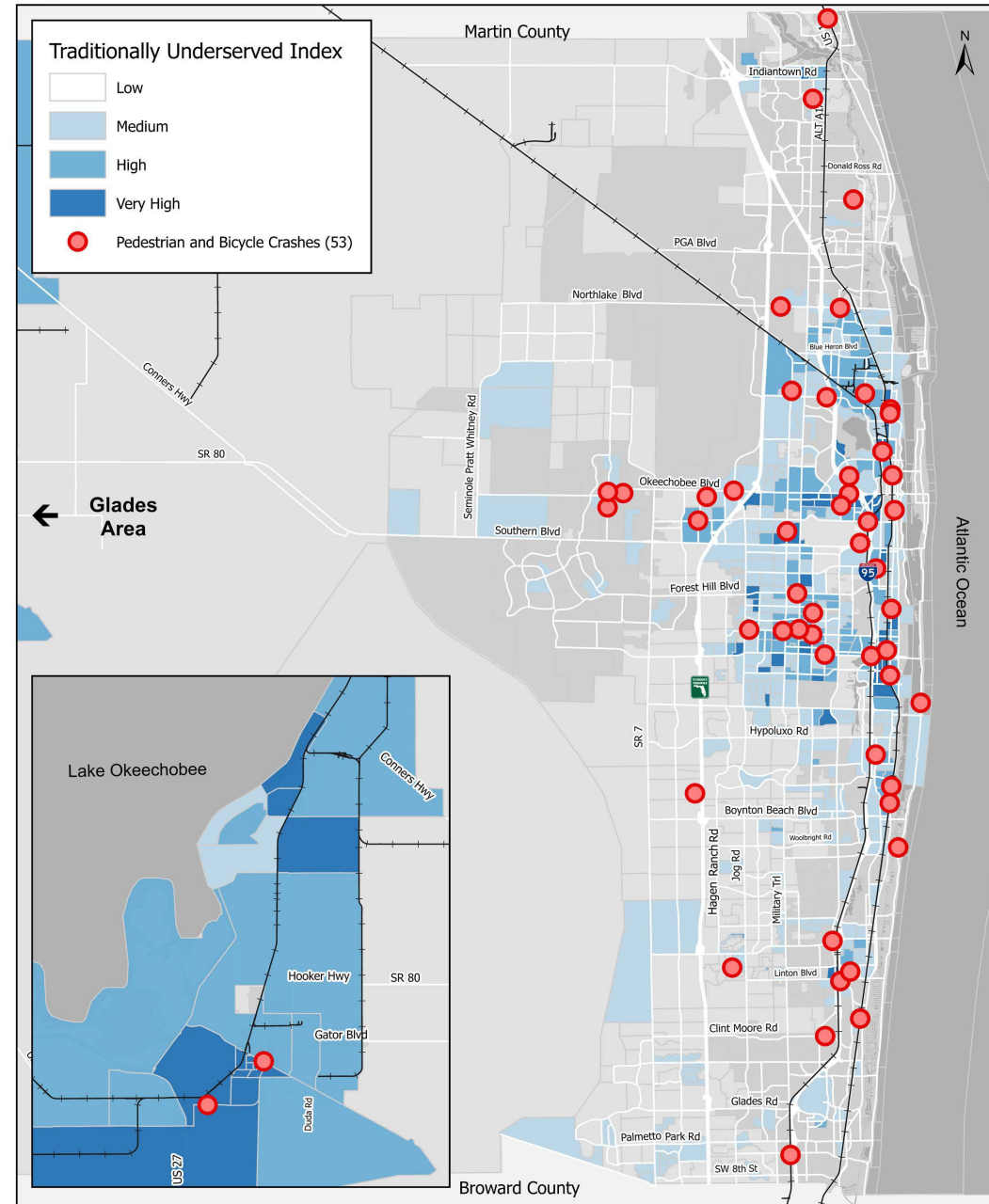
# Q4

# Crashes by Emphasis Area

## Roadway Conditions

69%

Of **pedestrian** crashes occurred midblock.



85%

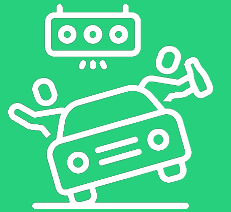
Of the crashes were on roads with posted speed limits of 35 mph or above.



## Human Behavior

**Impaired, Distracted, and Speeding & Aggressive Driving**

Contributed to a total of 4 crashes this quarter.



## Socioeconomic Conditions

**Aging drivers** continues as the leading age characteristic with most crashes (13%).

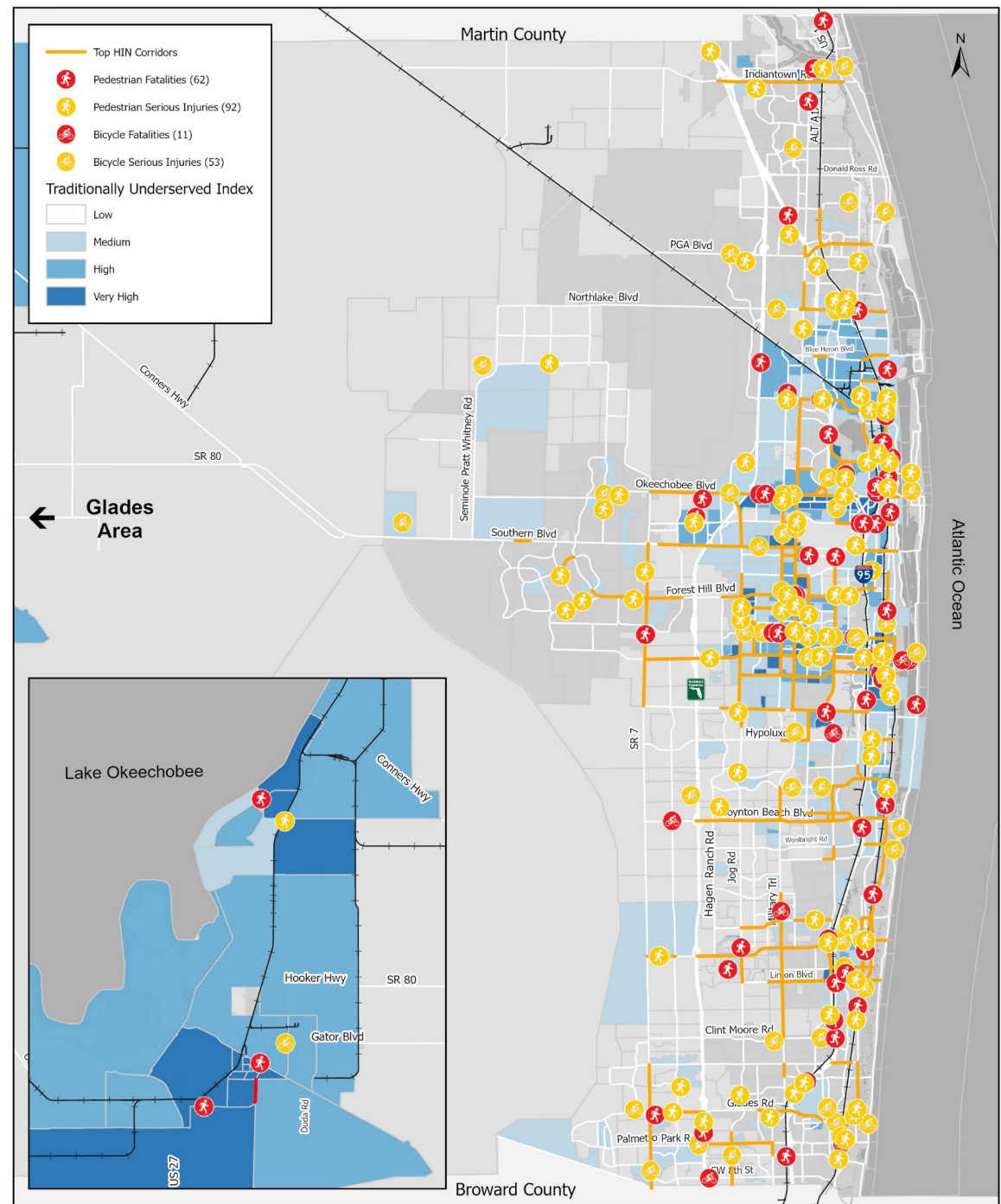
13 WHEREAS, Complete Streets aligns with the City of Boca Raton's Strategic

17 and maintained with a focus on safely accommodating people of all ages and abilities,



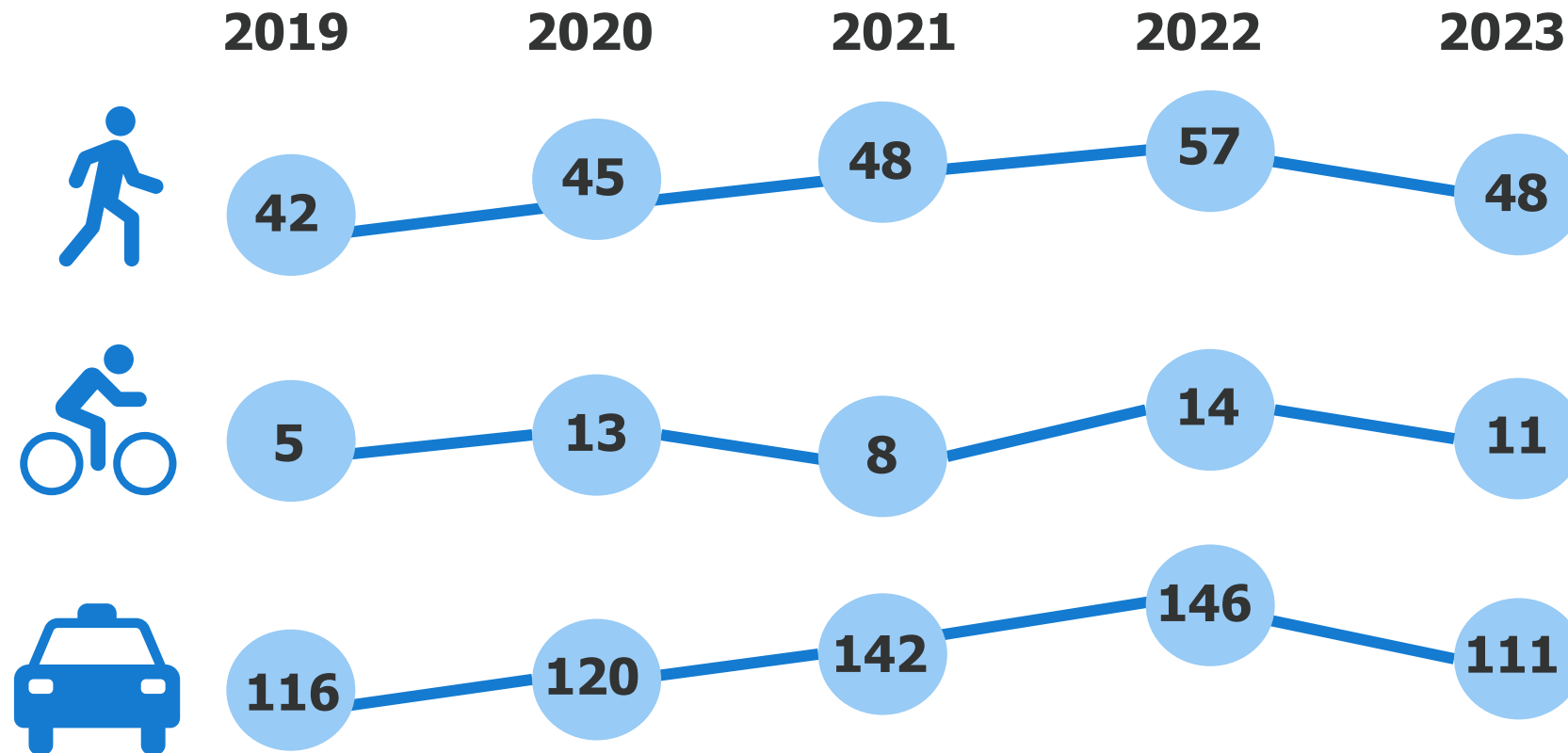
