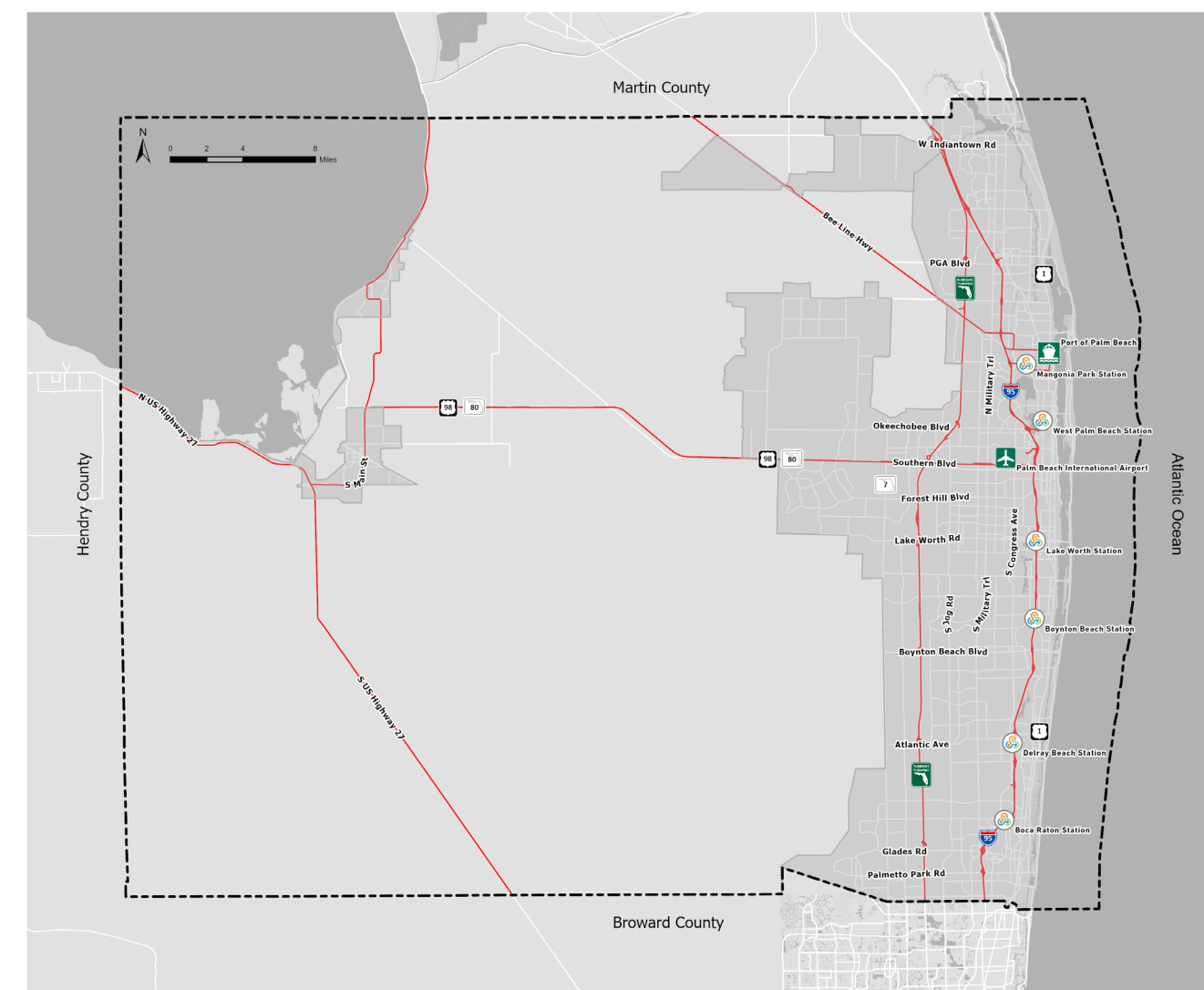
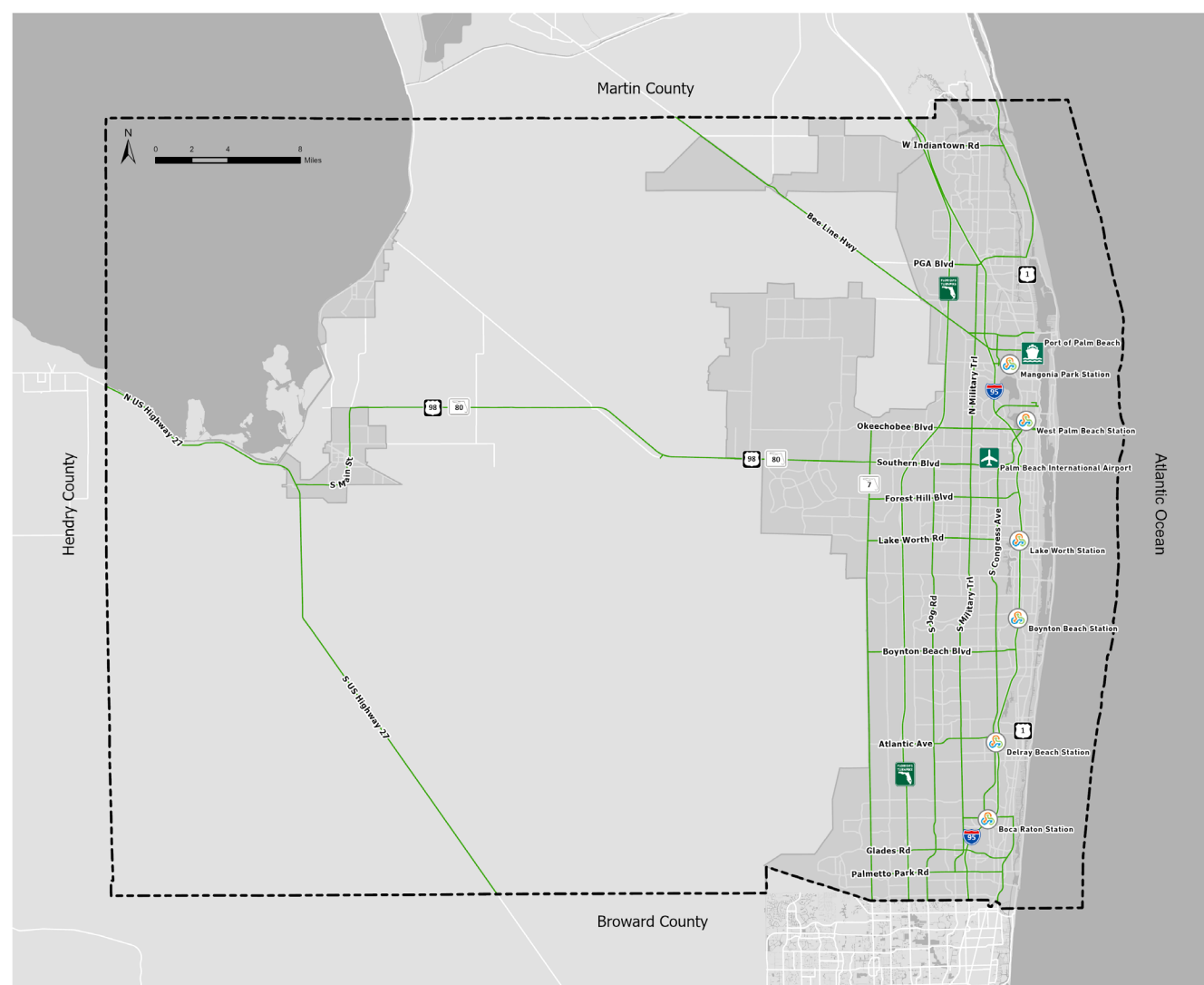
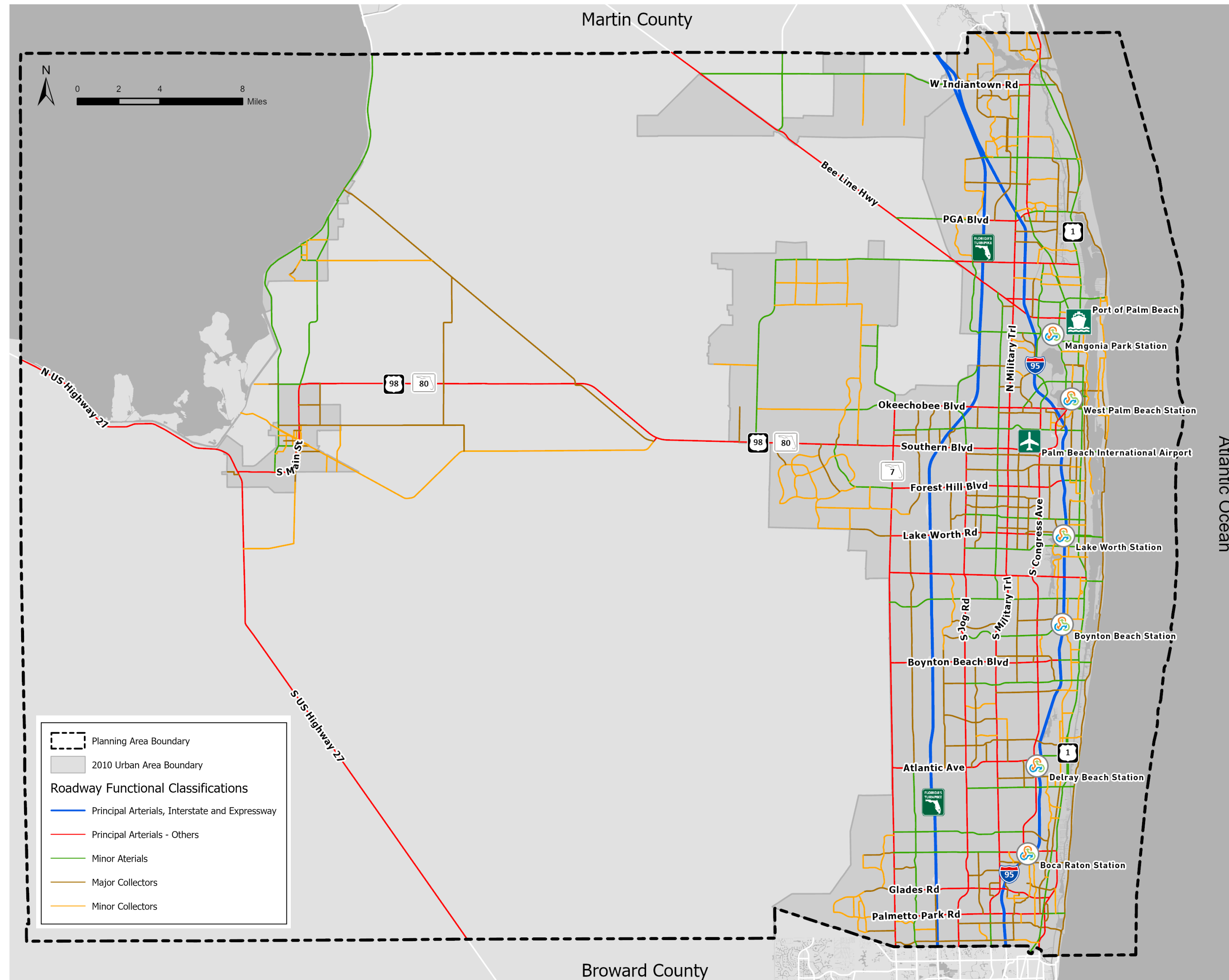


# FUNDING TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS

## FEDERAL AID ELIGIBLE NETWORK

The majority of federal funding is eligible to be spent on the federal-aid eligible network, which includes all major collector roadways and higher in Palm Beach County and minor collectors in the urban area. Additional maps include the National Highway System (NHS) on the left and FDOT's Strategic Intermodal System (SIS) on the right, where some specific sources of federal or state funding are directed.



## FUNDING SOURCES

The TPA approves federal & state transportation funding in the county. The main funding sources include:
