






Urban Area Boundary & Federal Aid Network





Transportation Alternatives

Purpose – Non-motorized infrastructure

Projects – Complete Streets, Bicycle and Pedestrian Infrastructure, Traffic Calming, Historic Preservation, Safe Routes to School

Eligible Roads – On and Off Federal-Aid Eligible Roadway Network

Annual Funding – ~\$5.1M/yr in federal funds **Funding Reimbursement** – \$1.5M per project Max / \$250K Min


